1. Novice Campdraft - \$700 prize money plus add backs

Nomination \$35 – Add back \$10

Ribbons to 8 places

One round and final.

2. Juvenile Campdraft (13 years and under 17 years)

\$150 prize money plus add backs

Nomination \$15 – add back \$5

Ribbons to 3rd, money to 6 places

One round only – Limited 2 horses per competitor

Highest scoring local rider prize

3. Junior working horsemanship Draft (8 years and under 13 years)

\$100 prize money – run in rodeo arena

Nomination \$free - Ribbons to 6th, money to 6 places

One round only – Limited 1 horse per competitor

4. Mini working horsemanship Draft (Riders under 8 years)

\$50 prize money – run in rodeo arena

\$400 prize money plus add backs

Nomination \$60 (\$15 cattle, \$30 add back, \$15 committee) pattern given early Saturday morning

Ribbons to 3rd, money to 3rd – limited 2 horses per competitor

First round includes dry work pattern and working cow horse in rodeo arena. Final will consist of one 'cattle working contest' round (wet work) only in main arena. No clean slate for final.

All competitors to ride at own risk. **Scratching within 7 days of the Campdraft 17th June 2017 will forfeit a \$10 fee per horse per draft. If a competitor withdraws within 72 hours prior to 8am on the first morning of the program, committees are entitled to keep the entire amount of the competitors nomination fee, unless when extenuating circumstances apply.** Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited". Competitors to run as per draw. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that the Comet Sport & Agricultural Show Society Inc. Committee and Comet Campdraft Association Inc will not be responsible in any respect for injury, loss or damage, personally or otherwise, which may be suffered by them in consequence of or in any way arising out of their attendance at the Campdraft and they must agree for themselves, their executors and administrator, to indemnify this Committee and members there to in respect of any claim. By-Laws and Rules of ACA Apply. The committee reserves the right to alter (delete) the program as it sees fit and as circumstances dictate. The Committee recommends all competitors wear riding helmets when competing. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Riders under the age of 18 must wear skull caps in the main arena. All riders must be ACA members.
