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Maiden A/B and Novice A/B:

For the Maiden and Novice Events, competitors are to nominate as usual:

- Maiden status horses can enter in the Maiden and the Novice; and
- Novice status horses can enter in the Novice and the Open.

By means of a draw, your horse will be placed into either 'Maiden A or Maiden B' and/or 'Novice A or Novice B'. If you have two maiden/novice horses, they will be entered in the separate competitions in the order they are entered into the event. No horse will compete in both Maiden A & B or both Novice A & B. Competitors **are not** permitted to nominate the day they compete unless in the case of extenuating circumstances in which the committee will determine on a case-by-case basis

Conditions of Nomination and Entry onto the Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Grounds:

The ACA, Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc, and owners of the property do not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, rider, beast, spectator or any other person or property whatsoever. As per the ACA Code of Conduct, a competitor shall accept and abide by the programme and requirements set by the ACA, Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc. and owners of the property. This includes (but is not limited to) the committee reserving the right to refuse nominations and on-site entry to individuals without explanation. By nominating in this event and/or entering the grounds, you are agreeing to abide by all conditions of entry. The Committee also reserves the right to alter the programme as deemed necessary.

Nominations:

Nominations will be online via the Campdraft Central Portal:

- Entries will open **6pm Tuesday 17th April 2018** for 24 hours or until cattle numbers are met.
- Visit <http://www.campdraftcentral.com.au> to login. Your Member Login is your ACA Membership # and Password (this can be found on your membership invoice or by contacting the ACA or Campdraft Central).
- Follow the prompts to enter in the relevant events.
- Make your payment after you receive your invoice via email.

- Strictly **no phone, faxed or emailed entries** will be accepted however in extenuating circumstances the Event Secretary can nominate for competitors.
- If payment is not received by **5pm Friday 20th April 2018**, your position will be given to the next wait-listed competitor.
- Any changes to your nominations can be made online through the Campdraft Central portal. Please advise the Event Secretary of any changes so it can be checked and/or competitors on waiting lists can be advised of available positions.
- You will be notified if you are on the waiting list and as positions are made available.



CAMPDRAFTCENTRAL

General ACA and Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc. Rules:

- NCCA / ACA Rules apply to all Campdrafts.
- Competitors are entitled to a **maximum of 8 first round starts**.
- Winnings will be paid 1st-8th place for Maiden, Novice, Restricted Open, Juvenile and Junior Campdrafts and 1st-6th for the Restricted Open Horse and Encouragement Campdrafts in accordance with the ACA guidelines R.9(b).
- Stallions to be double tied, stallions to have an exclusion perimeter erected around the animal by way of electrified tape around the horse and area they are tied to exclude any possible interaction between the stallion and another horse or human. Stallions are permitted to be unrestrained in panel yards throughout daylight hours but **must** be double tied after dark. Only 1 horse is permitted per enclosure. Panels must be a minimum height of 1500mm and constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of a minimum width of 25mm box/pipe equivalent. Panels must be securely anchored to a solid object (i.e. truck, post or tree). Junior and Juvenile age competitors are not permitted to handle or ride stallions whilst on the Boar Swamp Campdraft grounds.
- Junior age competitors may ride in Junior Campdraft events only.
- Juvenile age competitors may ride in all events except the Encouragement Campdraft.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- ACA Dress Code applies: Competitors to wear a helmet/hat, collared buttoned shirt, trousers and boots.

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- The organising committee reserves the right to alter the programme at any time. Cattle and daylight hours are limited.

Encouragement Rider Status:

- An Encouragement Campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won an Open age draft (i.e. Maiden, Novice, Open, Ladies, Associates) or a restricted draft.
- A win in an Encouragement Draft will not alter the status of the horse. Competitors cease to be eligible to compete after winning One (1) Encouragements, or one (1) open age campdraft or placing 3 times in an open age campdraft

ACA Membership:

- ACA Membership renewals for 2017/18 were due **1st April 2018**. Any competitor or person intending to ride a horse on the Boar Swamp grounds (even if not competing) **must** be a fully financial ACA member. Memberships can be renewed online at <http://www.campdraft.com.au>.

Programme Changes:

- As per ACA rule D.5 - No refunds will be given for scratching's made **within 3 days** prior to 8am on the morning of the first event, unless in the case of extenuating circumstances. If a scratching occurs 3-7 days before 8am on the day of the first event, the committee is entitled to retain \$15 per run. If the scratching occurs at least 7 days before the event, the competitor is entitled to a 100% refund.
- Ensure that any horse/rider programme changes are made through the office prior to the commencement of each event. Changes made prior to 72 hours before the event can be made online through the Campdraft Central Portal.
- A horse's draw **will not** be altered unless the rider misses their run due to campdraft organisation commitments on the day. Any other horse that misses its draw will be moved to last, **if time permits**.

Hay and Water:

- **Strictly NO hay** to be brought onto the property other than Lucerne Hay (weed free).
- Blythwood Pasture Hay and Oaten Hay will be available to purchase throughout the weekend.
- The Hay truck will make the rounds once on Thursday evening, twice on Friday and twice of Saturday.
- Watering points are provided. Bring your own fittings and hose/s.

*****Boar Swamp is sometimes a deep and dirty body of water. Please keep children and animals away *****

STRICTLY NO DOGS past the shed, near the camp/ arena or within the food preparation areas. Any dog/s creating a problem will be removed. All dogs to be kept at horse yard areas

Gates will be locked until Monday 23rd April. Any yards setup prior to then will be taken down as they will be in the way of daily farming operations and event preparation.

Any person requiring an ambulance whilst on the Boar Swamp Campdraft grounds or as a result of an activity related to a Campdraft event at Boar Swamp will be required to cover the cost of the ambulance. We recommend you check your own health insurance policy or seek cover with St John Ambulance.
