- All About First Aid will be in attendance for the duration of the event.
- There is NO POWER sorry. BYO Generators. Water is precious so please be mindful.
- Campfires are fine, provided all due care is taken. Please extinguish fires overnight.
- There are TOILETS and wood-fired SHOWERS up at the camping area, and toilets and gas-fired showers adjacent to the arena. PLEASE be clean, we have limited helpers.
- Stallions must be restrained in line with current ACA rules. ALL Electric fenced paddocks, even with no stallions, must be connected to working electric fence energisers. The liability associated with stallions, and more so to escaped horses of all sexes, extends to all horse owners.
- Camping on the OPPOSITE side of the bitumen to the arena. Note a purpose built cooler with a 2 cream tanks & toilet block. ALL camping is inside the cooler.
- Enter via a signed gateway on your right, straight opposite the grid to the house. Watch for mine traffic especially in the first and last hour of the day.
- There is a small murky dam inside the cooler. This is strictly an Out of Bounds area for all children. Please help to watch & monitor this.
- Please leave your camp sites clean, and stack any rubbish at the toilet blocks on departure.
- There is dodgy Telstra reception and good Optus reception at the grounds.
- NO dogs, not even small ones, at the catering and bar area please.
