### **CONDITIONS**

1. All Competitors must be financial Australian Campdraft Association Inc (ACA) Members or approved Committee Volunteers.
2. Nominations open on Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> March at 7am and close on Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> March 2018 at 7am and must be lodged online via [www.campdraftcentral.com.au](http://www.campdraftcentral.com.au)
3. Horses names in the order they are to run must be stated when nominating and can't be changed after the close of nominations.
4. Electronic Fund Transfer : Account Name – Eidsvold Rodeo Committee Inc.; BSB No. 084 838; Account No.56 780 3330 .
5. **The Committee reserves the right to –**
  - (a) **alter vary or cancel any part of the program** [including the maximum number of first round runs for each competitor]; **and**
  - (b) **refuse any nomination; and**
  - (c) **restrict each competitor to a maximum of ten (10) first round runs.**
6. Nominations refundable in full only if cancelled by 8am on Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2018. Late scratching will incur a \$15 Stock Levy. If any nomination is scratched after 8am on Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> March 2018, the entire amount of the nomination fee will be kept by the Committee unless extenuating circumstances apply.
7. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing plus a fee of \$20 in cash with the Secretary within one hour of the incident taking place.
8. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
9. Riders under 13 years are unable to ride in Open age events.
10. It is a condition of accepting a nomination that no competitor and horse owner, their executors, administrators or beneficiaries shall be entitled to make any claim demand or charge of any nature whatsoever against the Eidsvold Rodeo Committee Inc, the North Burnett Regional Council and the Australian Campdraft Association Inc or the members of such committees for any loss, accident injury or damage which may be suffered by such competitor or horse owner, their equipment or animals during the course of the program of events.
11. In the event of an EI or other outbreak all costs and obligations will be the responsibility of the horse owner.
12. Prize Money may not be paid at the event.
13. Stallions must be restrained in accordance with the National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) Rule 11.12.
14. At all times, persons present at the venue (i.e. the Eidsvold Showgrounds) shall abide by any request made by the Committee.
15. Unless approved by the Committee, no riders are to be in the Arena when events are being run.

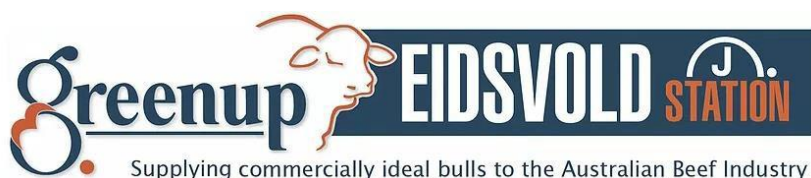
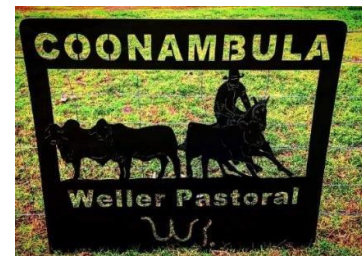
