- **“MAIDEN FOR MAIDEN WILL BREAK STATUS OF THE HIGHEST SCORING HORSE AND/OR RIDER”.** THE STATUS OF A HORSE WINNING A CAMPDRAFT WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE HIGHEST CLASS OF HORSE WITH EXCEPTION OF JUNIORS, JUVENILES, LADIES, OLD BUFFERS, ASSOCIATES AND ENCOURAGEMENT CAMPDRAFTERS. THE WINNER ATTAINS THE STATUS OF THE HIGHEST CLASS OF HORSE PARTICIPATING, EG: IF ONE OPEN HORSE COMPETES THEN IT IS CLASSED AS AN OPN DRAFT.
