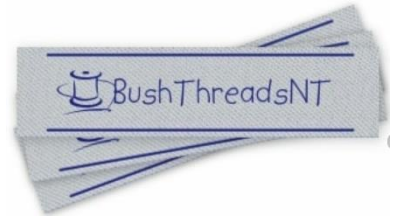

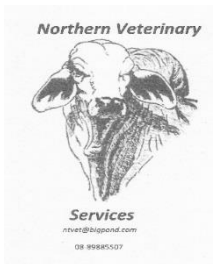

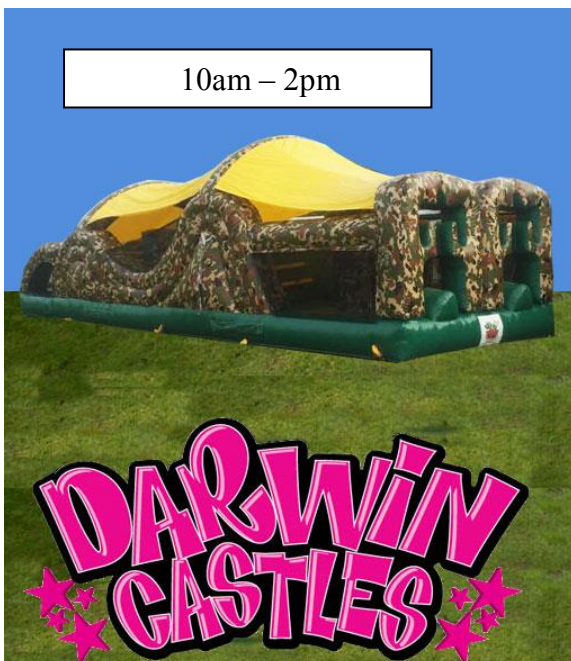

The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participat (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft.)

Adheres to ACA Rule D5; Refunds applicable to late scratchings will be at the discretion of the committee with each case to be treated on its merits. A 100% refund of the deposit shall be given if the competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 8am of the draft. A fee of \$15 can be retained if the competitor does not withdraw in the allotted time frame. If a competitor withdraws within 4 days prior to 8am of draft, committees are entitled to keep 100% of the competitors nomination fee, unless when extenuating circumstances apply. Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
